Scholarships



In order to be eligible for SD#27 Scholarships/Bursaries, **Grads** who are considering any type of post-secondary education must complete the application process (form and cover letter) before February 11th. Additionally, **Career Life Connections (CLC)** – is a required course for all graduates. CLC has 3 parts: 1) the CLC online Moodle course, 2) the Capstone project, and 3) work experience.

The CLC online Moodle course consists of 21 assignments to be completed by January 22, 2021 to enable marking and reporting on the second report card.

The work experience application was due at the end of September, we are still missing 38 forms. The capstone Project is due by April 28th, 2021.

Grade 7 FSA Exams

Assessment administration in schools runs from: January 18 - February 26, 2021. The Foundation Skills Assessment is an annual province-wide assessment of all B.C. students' academic skills in grades 4 and 7, and provides parents, teachers, schools, school districts and the Ministry of Education with important information on how well students are progressing in the foundation skills of Reading, Writing, and Numeracy.

Student Learning Survey

The Satisfaction Survey is an annual province-wide census of Grades 4, 7, 10 and 12 students, their parents and staff in public schools. The questions were developed with input from partner groups, teachers and experts in educational measurement and special education.

It usually takes about 30 minutes to complete the required survey questions – it may take longer depending on the number of questions added by schools and districts.
