1. UBC Centennial Scholars Entrance Award

Is your household struggling with expenses and university seems out of reach? You may be eligible for UBC's Centennial Scholars Entrance Award. The program supports academically qualified students who show an interest in UBC, but who would not otherwise be able to attend without significant financial assistance. If you are a Canadian citizen or permanent resident entering your first year undergraduate degree at UBC, and you demonstrate financial need, you are eligible. Your application requires a description of your circumstances, financial information pertaining to you and your family, and a reference letter. Learn more at ...

2. TD Scholarships for Community Leadership

This scholarship is awarded to students in their final year of high school and who have shown exceptional initiative in making a meaningful and lasting difference in their community. Each scholarship includes four years of tuition at any approved university of college in Canada, \$7500 per year towards living expenses, and offers of summer employment. The key criterion for this scholarship is outstanding community leadership.
