

Lake City Secondary School: Columneetza Campus Grade 7 Outdoor Education Focus

At Columneetza, we have a few classrooms with an Outdoor Education focus. All grade 7 curricular subject areas will be covered.

Personal Responsibility: This course involves moderate and high-risk field trips and travelling in rural and remote wilderness areas. These activities are incredibly rewarding but require a higher level of personal responsibility and care for the group.

Citizenship: A big part of the B.C. curriculum is social responsibility, i.e. how one contributes positively to one's family, community, society and the environment.

Place-Based Learning: Students enrolled in Outdoor Education will be visiting various community sites to cover the Grade 7 curriculum.

Funding: A program fee of \$75.00, along with parental volunteer support, will allow for overnight and day field trips.
